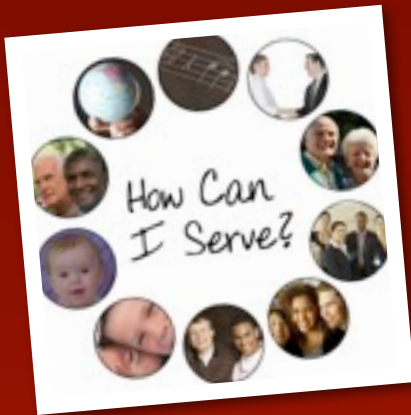

New Construction

Week By Week Update



We are building a brand new, 450-seat worship center in the front of our current church. Also planned is a complete renovation of our existing church, along with the renovation of our Parlor, Welcome Center, Lobby and hallways. New parking spaces and a new soccer field for our school is also being built. We expect to complete these projects sometime in the early summer.

This week the following began:

Roof structure and decking are being completed on the south side of the new sanctuary.

A slab is being poured for the utility courtyard.

The remainder of the structural steel is installed on the south elevation.

Steel stud wall framing is underway as carpenters install roof panels above and iron workers complete steel work above the main entrance beyond.
